

















| 3   |   | <b>Dry Coconut Halves</b>  |
| 1   | <b>Khadisakhar</b> (White Sugar Crystals) Packet   |  |

| *   | <b>Panchamrut</b> (Mixture of Milk, Curd, Honey, Sugar, Ghee)<br>Take a glass of cold milk, add 1 tea spoon honey, 1 tea spoon Ghee, 1 Tea Spoon Curd and 1 tea spoon sugar. Mix thoroughly. |  |

| *     | <b>Sweets</b> of your choice e.g. Pedha / Barphi / Laddu /khir etc... As per number of attendees.  |
| 5-10  | <b>Tulasi Leaves</b> (Holy Basil Leaves) if available  |
| 20-25 | <b>Flowers</b> Assorted (Rose, Marigold etc...)  |
| *     | <b>Ghee</b> for Niranjana (Ghee Lamp) 1 Bottle/Bowl  |
| *     | <b>Edible Oil</b> for Samai (Oil Lamp) 1 Bottle/Bowl   |
| 1     |  <b>Attar</b> - (Scent) small bottle  |
| 3-4   |  <b>Round Plates</b> (Stainless Steel /Plastic/Disposable) for keeping Pooja Material |

- Please keep all the material well organized in different plates arranged to the right side of the Pooja Chaurang (Chowki).
- Ensure that the Pooja begins on time so that it can be completed in time.
- Please have some relatives/friends to help you on the Pooja day as much as possible.
